Dear RAIC Syllabus Diploma Program students,

This is a call for project submissions to be considered for the 2024 Canadian Architect Student Awards competition. If you are interested in submitting, please carefully read through the below requirements, fill the submission form, and submit all required attachments to info@raic-syllabus.ca by no later than **Sunday, June 9, 2024**.

Our office will review all submission and enter the top 3 (THREE) projects to the 2024 Canadian Architect Student Awards.

Eligibility

The project may be completed by either an individual student or a group of students. However, the competition entrant must be an active student enrolled in RAIC690.

Judging Criteria

Awards are given for architectural design excellence. Jurors will consider the quality and originality of design research, as well as the scheme's response to program, site, and geographic and social context. They will evaluate its physical organization and form, its innovation in concept and process, and its demonstration of environmental and social awareness.

Submission Requirements

1) Anonymity. The student's name must NOT appear on the submission except on the entry form. The project name and location should be identified and MUST match the project name on the submission form.

2) Submission Entry. Each entry is to be submitted as a PDF file, consisting of up to six (6) pages in horizontal format no larger than 11" x 17" and a maximum file size of 25 MB. An additional single feature image of the project is required, not to exceed 3 MB in size.

2.1) Each entry should include drawings and images including site plan, floor plans, sections, elevations, renderings and/or model views.

2.2) Each entry should include a text of between 250-500 words on the first page of the PDF, consisting of a brief thesis statement and a description of how the ideas of the thesis were carried through in the building design.

3) Video (optional): You have the option to submit a video up to one (1) minute in length to explain the key concepts of your proposal. To submit the video, first upload it to a YouTube or Vimeo account that does not identify you or your school by name. Then paste the link in the video section of the submission. Also, include the link on the first page of your PDF submission. Please do not include links to any additional audio-visual materials, as they will not be considered.

Notification of winners

Submitting students will be notified if their project is being advanced for entry to the Canadian Architect Student Awards by June 20, 2024.

Award winners will be notified by Canadian Architect after judging takes place in October 2024.

Awards

A cash award of \$500 and a framed certificate will be given to each winning student entrant.

Publication

Winners will be published in a special issue of Canadian Architect in December 2024 and on its website. Credit for authorship will remain with the individual. Winners grant Canadian Architect the right to publish their winning submissions.
